- b. Safer Act The 5th request has been submitted.

- c. I re-submitted an AFG-S grant last week for just over \$37,000 for supplies used for the COVID-19 event.
- d. The new AFG application period has opened. Working on that application with the plan of applying for 10 AED's, 20 sets of Turnouts, 20 additional SCBA face masks, 12 Triband mobile radios and 20 pagers.
- e. We did receive a 50/50 matching grant from SDAO for Security to purchase more camera's to be installed in the building next door.
- f. Will be working with Murray Paolo on the Homeland Security Grant for Radios.
